

**BOE Announcement to All CPBPC Worshippers and Visitors  
(Updated Sat 21 March 2020)**

In light of the COVID-19 spike in Singapore, the Lord has placed in our hearts the need for additional measures for the safety of every worshipper and visitor.

Contact Tracing

Contact tracing will be enforced for all worshippers and visitors **from 22 March 2020 onwards**.

- **Registration:** Please register using the QR code or link below before you enter the church:

Information on your name, contact number, travel history and temperature will be collected.

- **Hand Sanitisation:** Every worshiper and visitor, except babies and toddlers, will have their hands sanitised as they enter the church.
- **Photographs:** Pictures will be taken of all worshippers and visitors through the CCTV cameras and by appointed PA crew members. These pictures will be used by the authorities for contact tracing, if necessary.

The above measures will also apply to all Bible Study and Fellowship meetings conducted inside or outside the church premises.

We apologise for the inconvenience caused.

Personal Safety Measures

We kindly seek your understanding and co-operation in the continued implementation of safety measures recommended by MOH at both the church and individual levels.

- **Church Level**
  1. If you have travelled overseas within the last two weeks, please stay-at-home and refrain from joining any church activities for a period of 14 days.
  2. If you have a fever or are experiencing other respiratory symptoms such as breathlessness or coughing, please seek immediate medical attention, rest at home and do not join any church activities.

- **Individual Level**

1. Practise good personal hygiene:
  - a. Wash your hands regularly with soap and water
  - b. Use hand sanitisers, if above is unavailable
  - c. Avoid touching your face
2. Avoid shaking hands – use alternative greetings
3. Stay at home if you are sick or not feeling well
4. Wear a mask if you are going out to see a doctor
5. Stay calm, be vigilant and keep up with official updates

### Live Streaming of Worship Services

The **Morning Worship Service (English)** and **Sunset Gospel Hour** will be suspended for the next 2-weeks (22 and 29 March 2020) in view of the enforcement of the 250 pax limit per event by MOH.
