

Church Camp Briefing 2018

Campers going by coach - Itinerary

1. **Departure to KL**

- ➡ Assemble in church (Fellowship Hall) by **6.45am** on Mon, 11th of June
- ➡ Rest stop - Yong Peng.

2. **Lunch stop** at IOI Mall (near Marriott Putrajaya)

- ➡ Estimated arrival time 12 to 1 pm.
- ➡ Bus captain will inform time to board bus for hotel.

3. **Hotel check-in**

- ➡ Official check-in time is 4 pm.

Campers going by coach - Reminders

1. Please check your assigned coach number at the back of the sanctuary.
2. Ensure passport has six months' validity.
3. Non-Singaporean (Domestic helper's foreign) passport - visas/travel docs ready.
4. Follow instructions of bus captains.
5. Please bring enough Ringgit for rest stop/lunch.

Campers driving

- Route guide will be available from Church web site. Hard copies available.
- Rest well the night before and convoy when driving in Malaysia.
- OBSERVE SPEED LIMITS & DO NOT seek private settlement if stopped by police.
- Complimentary parking for campers at the hotel.
- If you arrive early on Monday, you may deposit bags with the hotel reception.

Campers driving - Reminders

- **S\$10** in your Cash Card
- **RM\$200** in your Touch and Go card for check-point and toll charges.
- For those without Road Tax Disc (New LTA ruling 15/02/17):
 1. Valid copy of your vehicle's certificate of insurance
 2. A digital copy or printout of your vehicle's road tax validity available at LTA website
- 3/4 Tank rule.
- Pay up any Malaysian traffic fines via AXS machines beforehand

Check-in

- Early (Sat, 9th and Sun, 10th June)
 - check in directly at hotel reception desk.
- Mon, 11th June
 - check-in with our own camp registrars.
- Official check in time at 4 pm
 - seek your patience and understanding for room allocation.

Medical Needs - Reminders

- Bring their own basic travel medication for common ailments (cold, headache, fever, diarrhea, etc).
- Those with chronic conditions (e.g. hypertension, diabetes) should bring sufficient medications and, if needed, personal monitoring equipment (e.g. glucometer).
- Any campers who have been hospitalised in the 1 month before the camp are kindly requested to inform Dr Jonathan Tay (email: jonathan.tay@gmail.com, mobile: 83881228).
- Those with serious medical conditions who require clearance for travel are requested to consult their primary physician and, if possible, to obtain a memo summarising their medical issues should they require medical assistance while abroad.

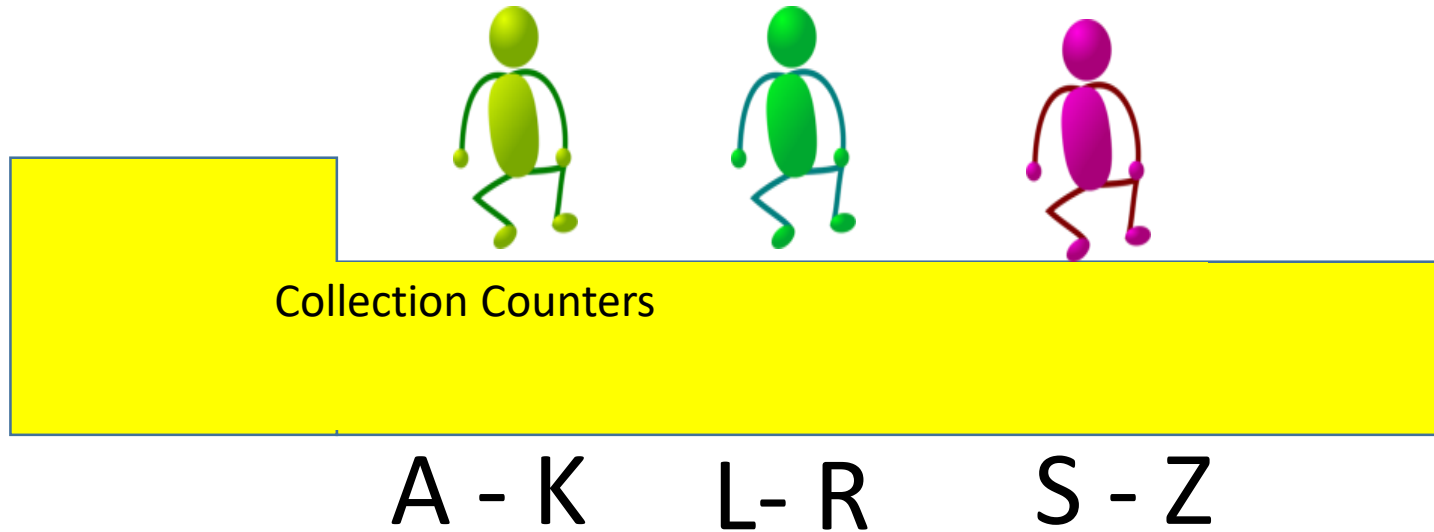
Children's Program
