

GUIDELINES FOR OVERSEAS CHILDREN MISSION WORK

For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many. (Mark 10:45)

When we go for a Mission Trip, we must always remember that we have to be a blessing to our fellow brethren there. The following must be kept in mind during the preparatory and execution stages of the Mission Work.

1. Pray

- a. God's Guidance as we form the team.
- b. All members of the team will serve with humility, joyfully and willingly.
- c. Strength and wisdom to plan and prepare for the trip.

2. Plan

- a. Appoint a Team leader, a Treasurer and a Secretary.
- b. Enquire and confirm the tasks required from the Overseas Mission station.
- c. Plan the schedule and teaching materials including Art & Craft items.
- d. Plan the distribution of responsibilities to team members.
- e. Plan travel dates and all logistics arrangement. Minimize inconveniences to the host.

3. Prepare

- a. Teaching materials.
- b. Art & Craft materials.
- c. Advance booking for transport and accommodation.

4. Proceed

- a. Execute the plan and be a blessing to all the brethren.
- b. Serve together helping one another and forbearing one another.
- c. Focus on the mission work instead of recreation.
- d. Accommodate to changes during the trip.
- e. Avoid murmuring and complaining.
- f. Avoid being a burden to the host.

5. Post-Trip report

- a. A short report of about 150 words.
- b. Submit 3 photos taken during the trip.
- c. Above will be use to create awareness on the OCM notice board located at the 2nd Floor lift lobby.

6. Have a Pleasant and Blessed trip! *For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister. (Hebrews 6:10)*
